



## Hill Country Film Festival and Fritztown Cinema To Screen Texas-made Feature Film **SIRONIA**

### *Monthly Series Features Free Screening of Independent Feature Film*

**AUSTIN, Texas (May 25, 2017)** – The [Hill Country Film Festival](#) (HCFF), an annual independent film event in Fredericksburg, Texas, to be held April 26 – 29, 2018, and presented by the Hill Country Film Society, has partnered with [Fritztown Cinema](#) to host a screening of the feature film [SIRONIA](#) (d. Brandon Dickerson) as part of its “indie film series” in Fredericksburg.

**WHAT:** **SIRONIA** is inspired by the music of singer-songwriter Wes Cunningham, and is the story of a talented musician who has been chewed up and spit out by the Hollywood music machine. Frustrated by his broken career, Thomas Fisher (Wes Cunningham) and his wife Molly (Amy Acker) impulsively pack up and move to small town Sironia, Texas, to live a more authentic life and raise their first child near Molly's brother and his family. Despite the change of scenery, Thomas' deep resentment over his lost dreams gets the best of him as he struggles to find peace with his stalled career, until he remembers what he loved about music - and Molly - in the first place.

Director Brandon Dickerson will be in attendance for Q&A following the screening.
