to Screen New Release of
AMANDA AND JACK GO GLAMPING**

Special Screening of Texas-made Feature Film by Local Filmmaker

AUSTIN, Texas (Oct. 25, 2017) – The Hill Country Film Society, a non-profit organization committed to providing year-round independent film programming and education in the Texas Hill Country and host to the annual [Hill Country Film Festival](#) in Fredericksburg, Texas, on April 26-29, 2018, has partnered with [Fritztown Cinema](#) to host a special screening of [AMANDA AND JACK GO GLAMPING](#) (d. Brandon Dickerson, U.S.) in Fredericksburg.

WHAT: **AMANDA AND JACK GO GLAMPING** is a comedy shot in Texas and written and directed by Fredericksburg resident Brandon Dickerson. The film, acquired by Gravitas Ventures and Orion Pictures, will premiere at the Austin Film Festival on October 29 and have a limited theatrical release on November 10.

With his marriage on rocky ground, dejected one-hit author Jack Spencer (David Arquette, **NEVER BEEN KISSED**) agrees to go “glamping” with his wife Amanda (Amy Acker, Marvel’s “The Gifted”) in search of a spark. A romantic getaway turns into a group ordeal when they realize they’ve been double-booked with honeymooning hipsters and the handsome, eco-friendly landowner Nate (*Designated Survivor*’s Adan Canto) enters the picture. Jack must learn to get over himself as he dives deep off the grid into a comedic exploration of love, failure, relevance and miniature donkeys Academy Award® nominee June Squibb also stars.
